



Growing our Own **Medical Assistants**

UMass Memorial Health in partnership with the SHARE Union and Quinsigamond Community College

Overview

Medical Assistants play a critical role at UMass Memorial Health and are considered a 'hot' job. As part of our new workforce development efforts, we are launching a Medical Assistant Apprenticeship Program to assist caregivers in obtaining the education and training needed to become a medical assistant. This full-time, hands-on 'earn and learn' program is designed so caregivers can gain new skills needed to advance their career while earning a salary and maintaining benefits. In exchange, caregivers are asked to make a one-year commitment to working as a medical assistant at UMass Memorial Health.

Program Highlights

- Paid training program for all eligible UMass Memorial Health staff
- Maintain a salary and benefits while going to school
- Education and support to obtain certification within one year
- Upfront tuition, fee, and book payments with no -out of pocket expense
- Results in a job as a Medical Assistant II after receiving certification

Caregiver Eligibility

- All UMass Memorial Health's full-time and part-time (24+ hours) caregivers employed for 6 months or more. Per diems and contractors are not eligible.
- Caregivers must be in good standing with UMass Memorial Health at the time their application is submitted. Those with written warnings and final written warnings within the last twelve (12) months will not be eligible to apply.
- Have a high school diploma, GED, HiSET or equivalent
- Make a commitment to the time and the effort to complete all training requirements
- Have basic math and intermediate English language proficiency
- Ability to attend class Monday–Friday eight hours/day at QCC for 8 weeks
- Willingness to make a work commitment to UMass Memorial Health for one year following successful completion of apprenticeship.
- No physical restrictions (able to stand, lift, pull, bend, handle objects etc. without assistance)
- Complete training satisfactorily according to quality and safety standards

Program Capacity

- Cohort 3 / Fall 2025: 10- 15 caregivers.
- Cohort 4/ To be determined

Application Process

Caregivers will complete the following steps:

1. Complete Online Interest Form: Medical Assistant Interest Form
2. Attend an Information Session
3. Signup and Complete the WorkKeys career assessment
4. Talk to Quinsigamond Community College

5. If recommended by QCC, complete application in Workday, including resume and personal statement.
 - Resume: Updated with current job
 - Personal Statement: Provide a 2-3 paragraph written statement that describes why you would like to be a medical assistant. Describe your personal qualities or traits that will make you a good fit for the position.
 - Medical Assistant Apprenticeship Clinic Interest Questionnaire Form
6. Screening panel meeting with Workforce Development, SHARE Union, and Talent Acquisition
7. (Optional) Medical Assistant Job Shadow
8. Interview with Hiring Manager(s)

Becoming A Medical Assistant

Caregivers selected to participate in the apprenticeship program will complete the following steps:

- Transfer from their current job into a new MA I position. Caregivers will remain in this position during classroom training at Quinsigamond Community College and during their clinical training.
- Caregivers will work full-time at the Med Center or Community Medical Group clinic designated to them during the interview process.
- Caregivers will take the certification exam within 12 months of working full-time in permanent position. Support and test preparation will be provided.
- Caregivers can advance to an MA II position and receive a wage gain upon passing the certification exam and receiving certification.
